THE BOOK OF REVELATION IS

- Apocalyptic (1:1)
 - Uses vision, symbols, and allegories
 - Reveals a heavenly perspective
 - Describes past, current and future events
- Prophetic (1:3)
 - Who God is (God's Covenant/Commandments)
 - What God Desires (Our Sin/need for repentance)
 - What God Demands of His People (Consequences/what will happen)
- An Epistle (1:4)
 - Written to a specific people
 - Written for specific situations
 - Applicable for future individuals

 - Take to heart (heed/obey)



"Write in a book everything you see and send it to the seven churches in the cities of Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia, and Laodicea." – Revelation 1:11
