


### WHAT IS A FRIEND?

#### THE VINEYARD

- Vineyard (Garden) with a wall around it (Genesis 2:10-14)
- Gave the vineyard to tenant farmers (Genesis 2:15-17)
- Tenant farmers were to cultivate and grow and produce a profit (Genesis 12:1-4)
- Sent servants to collect the profit and they were beaten stoned and killed (Old testament prophets)
- Sent His son to collect the profit and they killed him (Gospels)

### THE LIFE OF KINGS

#### This worlds Kings

- Born in castles
- Announced to the elite
- Viewed as the heir to the throne

#### Jesus

- Born in a manger (Luke 2:7)
- Announced to the poor and forgotten (Luke 2:8)
- Rejected by his own people (Matthew 2:3: Isaiah 53:3)
- Left a world of perfection to enter a world of sin and pain (John 3:13 and Philippians 2:5-8)



### THE ATTITUDE OF CHRIST

#### **John 3:13**

No one has ever gone to heaven and returned. But the Son of Man has come down from heaven.

#### Philippians 2:5-8

You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had.

Though he was God,

he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to.

Instead, he gave up his divine privileges;

he took the humble position of a slave

and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form,

#### WHAT COMES AFTER FRIENDSHIP...

But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things! – Galatians 5:22-23

- This is not how we have to be to come to God; but rather what we will be transformed into from a relationship with God
  - Repentance, sorrow, a desire to change
